We wanted to give you an update on how things are progressing in our efforts to go to Spain long term. It has been a little slower than we had hoped. As you know we have filed to establish our own nonprofit organization. Since we will be working overseas, the process is longer and we have not gotten a reply yet. This was a little discouraging but we are **trusting God's timing.** They said they will get back to us by the middle of December.

We are keeping a heart of thanksgiving as we move forward. We have been visiting a few of the area churches to raise more support and



Praise God we are making progress. We have a few more people who give on a monthly basis and God is calling more prayer warriors. We estimate we need about \$8,000.00 more before we can confidently apply for the visa.

Until we are able to go to Spain long term, we thought we would make the best of the situation.

We have been volunteering at the Austin Charis Bible College Extension School. The school meets in San Marcos, about 20 minutes from where we are living. It is a hybrid school so they do most of the work at home and only meet twice a month on Saturdays. Students come from various regions of Texas to attend. Some travel as far as from Brenham and Houston.

We had a chance to share our vision with the students. They were excited to become a part of what we are doing. We hope that one day a group of students will come to Spain to do outreaches with us. We will be the hands and feet on the ground preparing things for them to come. Once they leave we will still be there discipling those reached. We hope some of the affiliated churches will also send short term missionaries to come help.

God keeps encouraging us along the way.

We didn't want to make a long term lease so we can easily leave for Spain when the door opens. God led us to a room for rent in a house not to far from our kids. When I contacted the owners, I found out they are believers. They even have a house church in their home. Last week they went on a vacation and Wayne and I were able to take over the service. It was a privilege to share with this small group. We believe God used us to bring some healing, wisdom and freedom to those who attended.

We are continually looking for opportunities to share Christ. We went with the church members to a local nursing home. We sang worship songs with the patients and prayed for people.



More About Our Vision Moving Forward

I wish we could say exactly what we will be doing in Spain but truth is it will probably be some trial and error to see what works. We like the house church approach and will probably start with that. We will do the Discipleship Evangelism Bible studies and use Wayne's music to minister to people.

I am sure we will be still working along side the missionaries and pastors we met while we were there in the past. We plan to continue to share the Gospel by teaching English and using Bible stories as a means to teach God's love.

Hopefully I will continue to work with Saleou, the Muslim woman I have been meeting with each visit to Spain. I was blessed the other day when she called to let me know she was in Senegal visiting her parents. I love hearing from her and knowing she wants to continue our relationship.

Another plan is to purchase a portable projector to take Christian videos and teachings into the greenhouse areas around Roquetas de Mar.

Where ever we are it is our desire to tell people how much God loves them. We want to let people know He is a good God, and Jesus paid the price for our sins. He died and rose again so that we can be reconciled to Him and to each other.
