Our Calling:

2 Corinthians 5:18-21(AMP)

But all these things are from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Christ [making us acceptable to Him] and gave us the ministry of reconciliation [so that by our example we might bring others to Him],¹⁹ that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not counting people's sins against them [but canceling them]. And He has committed to us the message of reconciliation [that is, restoration to favor with God]. ²⁰ So we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were making His appeal through us; we [as Christ's representatives] plead with you on behalf of Christ to be reconciled to God. ²¹He made Christ who knew no sin to [judicially] be sin on our behalf, so that in Him we would become the righteousness of God [that is, we would be made acceptable to Him and placed in a right relationship with Him by His gracious loving kindness].

Our Story

Wayne was born again in 1972 after a friend told him about Jesus. Wayne later had an encounter with God which was so powerful he couldn't move. He heard the Lord tell him that he would **"go to Africa by way of Spain."** He didn't initially follow those words but held them in his heart for many years.

Sandy attended church as a child and had a desire to be a missionary to Africa. She didn't accept Christ as her savior and Lord until 1983 after making a mess of her life. She cried out to the Lord who rescued her. We later met and married in 1988.



Since then, we have been serving God as Sunday School and Bible Study teachers. Wayne has been on the Worship team, blowing his harmonica for Jesus.

Sandy served and worked for the Christian prolife crisis pregnancy center for about 10 years. She also spent many years as a stay at home mom, raising her kids and teaching them at home.

In 2012 a new season in our lives began, as our youngest son was about to graduate from high school. We started to wonder what God had for us next. While getting ready for work, we were both watching The Gospel Truth television show; God spoke to us separately, and gave us both the desire to go to Charis Bible College.

New Chapters in our Story

We sold our home and most of our belongings, bought a 5th wheel, and headed to school. We did our first year at the San Antonio extension school and then in August 2014 we moved to Woodland Park, CO to study at the main campus. We received great teaching and greater revelation of God's love and our authority from His Word.

We graduated in May 2016 after completing the 3rd year Mission school. We knew God was calling us to the nations.



Matthew 28:18. And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. ¹⁹ Go therefore and **make disciples of all the nations**, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit ²⁰ teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.

Since beginning our adventure, we have been blessed to share His love and hope in Romania, Colombia, the Dominican Republic, Las Vegas, Mexico, Kenya, Germany, and Spain. This was all preparation time. Always keeping Wayne's encounter with the Lord in mind.

We loved traveling to different places and doing evangelism but realized short term mission trips are great for making converts but not so great for **making true disciples.**

Making Disciples

In September of 2018 we went to Birkenfeld Germany for several months to do an internship with World Outreach. While we were there we saw lives changed. We saw how effective a long term relationship discipling others can be and the potential of inspiring new disciple makers.

We feel like God has called us to return to Spain long term to fulfill the vision Wayne had when he was younger. When we went to Spain we realized there is a great need for the Gospel. The area we feel called to is near Almeria. There are 100 different people groups living there and according to the Joshua Project this area is **less than 2% evangelical** and 11% Muslim.

We realized what a great opportunity there is to spread the Gospel. Our vision is to reach at least one person from each of these 100 people groups and equip them to disciple through Discipleship Evangelism Bible Study. We pray they will go back to their home communities and share the Gospel, **this way, together we can change the world.** There is a great number of English speaking Africans there due to the jobs in the thousands of greenhouses. We now understand what God meant when He said "go to Africa by way of Spain."
