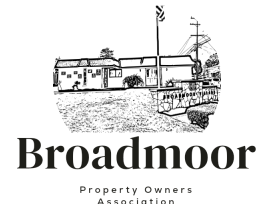

11. Broadmoor Police Business (7:22)
- a. Police Chief Report
 - i. A group of individuals in SSF were committing vehicle related thefts but it has been broken up
 - ii. The BPD has not filed for bankruptcy
 - 1. There will be a special meeting with the police commission in the next two weeks
 - 2. We are going to make it through december and beyond if we are frugal with expenditures and overtime

- a. This is not accounting for any additional funds
- iii. Measure K funds
 - 1. Supervisor Canepa does not have any fellow supervisor support to provide Broadmoor with the funds
 - 2. There was no support for the proposal of using Measure K funds to support the police department
 - 3. Bradmoor in general may receive some Measure K funds but not likely to support the police department
- iv. Ballot measure
 - 1. In 1992/1993 past there was a grass root effort to support a ballot measure which did pass but it was a small margin
 - 2. BPD has received a quote from a firm to support generating the ballot measure and do feasibility studies and marketing etc (in the realm of 150K)
 - 3. 75K retainer required for bankruptcy
- b. LAFCO
 - i. BPD has been providing them information including information regarding the ballot measure and bankruptcy
 - ii. Request that individuals still send messages to LAFCO
 - 1. Ask neighbors and family members to send messages
 - 2. David: San Mateo County is not concerned with how much Broadmoor cares about the BPD
- c. Messaging around package theft
 - i. Porch piracy spikes this time of year
 - 1. Add to the website
 - 2. Charge front door camera
 - ii. Advocate of ring door camera
- d. Question
 - i. Is there a date set for the special commission meeting?
 - 1. Not yet may, be 28th of Nov. More than likely will be a daytime meeting.
- e. Meeting with Sheriff Corpus
 - i. The County Sheriff's office is concerned that they are being made to look bad
 - ii. They feel that Chief Connolly misrepresented the their deployment plan
 - 1. They have asked that Chief Connolly not speak about they Sheriff's office
