Outlaw Softball (OS) powered by NSA

OS RULES

(Updated 3/26/18)

Tournaments are run as "OUTLAW" Paper Roster Tournaments. All teams are REQUIRED to have a sanction or membership on the www.playnsa.com website as an "OUTLAW" team. Team will be assigned a number specific to the Outlaw program.

Outlaw Softball Membership Fee \$25.00 - Per 20 person roster. If the 20 person roster is filled, a new outlaw TEAM MEMBERSHIP form is filled out by the coach/manager and when paid, the new team will receive a separate membership number. The new membership number will then be eligible to use a new 20 person roster.

- NSA Approved 44/400 Softballs "ICON"
- Class of play - Choose your Class by Home Run Rule
 - Four (4) Out
 - One (1) Out
- Paper Roster program with waiver – will be available on www.PlayOutlawSoftball.com
 - Players name, **NSA Player Number**, DOB and signature – Fill in roster available online
 - All participating players will be required to have a NSA lifetime player number prior to participating. If a player already has an NSA number, PLEASE DO NOT apply for a new one.
 - Official OS Roster with signatures must be turned in for each tournament prior to participation.
 - Once the 20 person roster is full, the team will need to apply for another 20 person roster.
- NSA Rule Book with these exceptions
 - Designated Runner (DR) - DR is not in the batting line-up and can run as often as needed. No restrictions on number of times used, except cannot be put in for a different batter/runner if already ON BASE.
 - Designated Home Run Hitter (DHH) The DHH can hit unlimited home runs in addition to the Home Run Rule. **Note:** If the DHH is walked then the team gets a free HR in that inning by any player, even if the team is over their Home Run Limit.
 - One (1) DHH is allowed in class One (1) - Out
 - Two (2) DHH's are allowed in class Four (4) - Out
 - 3' Pitchers Box (Floating)
 - 1 n 1 count with 1 to waste
 - All players can bat – If player leaves or is ejected from game and there is no substitute, the spot in the line-up will be an out, you can't walk the open spot in the line-up to get to a 3rd out. If there is a walk and it is third out in line-up you skip that spot.
 - Home Run Rules - Anyone can hit a home run, but the DHH can hit unlimited home runs in addition to the Home Run Rule. **See DHH rule above.**
 - Four (4) - Out (Four Home Runs - any additional HR's not by the DHH are recorded as an out)
 - One (1) - Out (One Home Run - any additional HR's not by the DHH are recorded as an out)
 - Strike Mat is a Tournament Directors OPTION to use
 - Rules not covered above will be referred back to the NSA Rule Book
