Pictured above are Thanh (graduated in 2014), Ngan, (graduated in 2015), Theresa (graduated in 2014), and Emily (graduated in 2013). Thanh and Theresa were dropped off at the orphanage front door. Ngan was found abandoned at the market as a baby and she was brought to the orphanage. Emily's father died of HIV and her mother is mentally ill and is in a mental health institution. Social services took Emily from her mother and brought her to Sister Danielle at the Orphanage. Thanh, Ngan, and Theresa decided to start a babysitting/daycare business in 2015 and took the courses and became licensed. Emily joined them in 2017. They live in District 11 in Ho Chi Minh City. They babysit for working couples. Thanh and Theresa are now married. Thanh, Ngan, and Theresa sing in the choir with the Nuns every day at 4:30 am! Emily was one of the first recipients of the bikes that the Children of the Dust Charity gives all graduates so that they have transportation to and from work.
