Thank you for your interest in helping us sew together our **Bags of Love**. Here are step by step instructions to guide you on your way. *The most important thing to remember: these do not have to be perfect, so don't worry about a crooked seam or a drawstring that is just a little bit too short.* They need to be made with love and a prayer that the person receiving whatever is inside may feel the love in turn.

Step 1:

Each bag is not perfectly cut out which is okay because once it is sewn together you won't be able to tell. Material should be cut to 34" x 24".



Step 2:

Fold down one of the 34" sides approximately 2". You will sew 2 straight lines. One approximately 1" from the top of the fold and the other about 3/4" be-



low that one. This is creating the path for the drawstring.





Step 3:

Once both lines are sewn, use your rotary cutter or pinking shears to cut away the excess material so there is a nice clean edge about 1/4" wide.





Step 4:

Fold bag in half matching up the top (it should be the "good side" in). Begin sewing at the top of the bag about 1/4" down so



you can backstitch to reinforce the corner.

Step 5:

Sew down the long side of the bag turning at the corner until you reach the end of the short side. Be sure to back-stitch at both bottom corners to reinforce them.



Step 6: Use your rotary cutter or pinking shears to cut off the excess material so there is a nice clean edge. You have completed the bag. Now it just needs to be turned right side out and one of our non-sewing volunteers will turn out your bag and install the drawstring.
