Please let Kent know of any broken or non-working tools, including the sprayers. The new backpack sprayers seem to have pieces missing and are not emptied when brought back. If you have spraying issues, please leave Tommy Grilli a note on the seat of the spray wagon. Looks like between PRIDES and the County, the weed issue seems to be better.

The County is planning spraying preemergent for the weeds and PRIDES has been using the granular Preen. We are looking into a liquid pre-emergent rather than granular.

Snowbirds are leaving and crews will have fewer members each Saturday. If you have a section that needs extra workers please let me know.

The County gave us "eco-friendly" trash bags to try out. They may work fine for leaves, but anything sharp, pokes holes in the plastic bag and the contents spills out. Orange bags and clear bags work best. Be sure not to load the bags too heavy for the County workers to throw them into a dump truck. More bags, less weight, please.

Stay hydrated and safe. The extra cones seem to help at the turn lanes of the roads. See you on "payday."
