Boardman Arts Park: *Fright Night*

Boardman Arts Park, Where Community and Creativity Meet

Fright Night is back at Boardman Arts Park on October 1, 2022 from 6-10:00 PM! Get ready to ring in Spooky Season with an adult Halloween party at the Park!

Boardman Arts Park is thrilled to be hosting Fright Night once again this year on October 1 from 6-10:00 PM. The highlight of this event is a rocking concert performance by Columbus' RadioTramps. RadioTramps has the distinction of being a "first-class pop/rock/dance cover band featuring danceable radio hits from the 80s to current". This will be the first concert in Boardman Arts Park's newly updated Imagination Space, under string lights!

This adult Halloween party promises a fun-filled night, with, in addition to the RadioTramps concert, a costume contest, Tarot card readings by The Tarot Fairy, and a spooky scavenger hunt through the Haunted Zombie Field, with stops at the "Spider Nest Room", "Graveyard", "Butcher's Bloody Den", "Creepy Murderer's Truck", and the "Box Room". Prizes will be awarded to winners of the costume contest and the Haunted Zombie Field drawing. Above the Light is providing a photo booth so attendees can commemorate the night with a take-home photo. Food trucks at the event will include Holy Crepes, Dan's Deli, Libélulas Sugar's Cake, and Hogback Bbq Pit. Beer and wine will also be available for purchase from Old Dog Brewery.

"Fright Night has so much to offer this year," says Roxanne Amidon, Director of Boardman Arts Park, "A rocking good band, a terrifying zombie fright field, yummy food and drinks cast a magical, satisfying spell on all who attend!"

Entry to Fright Night is \$10 per person. You must be 18 years or older to attend the event. You will need a valid government-issued ID to validate your age to be admitted into the event. Due to the nature of this event no one under 18 will be admitted, including young children and babies in strollers. All tickets are non-refundable, and the event will go on rain or shine.
