

Wrap Aftercare

Wait at least 7 days before washing your vehicle post-installation.

Warranty coverage: 1 year; only covers installer error (not negligent maintenance!!): lifting at the edges, bubbling.

-DO NOT let your vehicle chronically bake under the sun (causes premature fading/cracking); garage-keep your vehicle as much as possible, as wraps that are kept outside will inherently have a shorter lifespan than garage-kept wraps

-DO NOT allow bird droppings to sit on the wrap for long periods (causes irreversible degradation of the wrap, even after you clean it off)

-DO NOT allow water to bake on the surface of the wrap (causes aggressive/irreversible water spots and/or degradation)

-DO NOT park next to trees that release tree sap (the sap hardens and becomes difficult to remove the longer it remains on the vehicle)

-DO NOT use automatic car washes as the primary way of keeping your vehicle clean. Hand-wash your wrapped vehicle either on your own or by having a professional detailer wash it every week, or immediately after it rains, gets muddy, etc.

If you prefer using a car wash, go through “touchless” car washes only. (Note that a “soft touchless” car wash is not the same! True touchless car washes are sometimes found at gas stations like Valero)

-DO NOT try to remove stubborn stains by using a pressure washer directly on the paint; the wrap will tear.

-DO NOT expect a ceramic coating to keep your vehicle exempt from washes! Ceramic coatings should only be an add-on to your regular maintenance routine

-DO NOT consistently drive over 80+mph, especially behind semi trucks or on country roads with a lot of road debris or roads with heavy construction (eg, on roads with freshly laid gravel) as this will tear away at your wrap. The likelihood of seeing rock chips on your wrap increases exponentially with speeds above 75mph, so be a mindful driver.
