We will have a recognition video on the Sunday before memorial day to remember all those who have served. If you would like a loved one remembered please submit a picture with details to the Church Office.



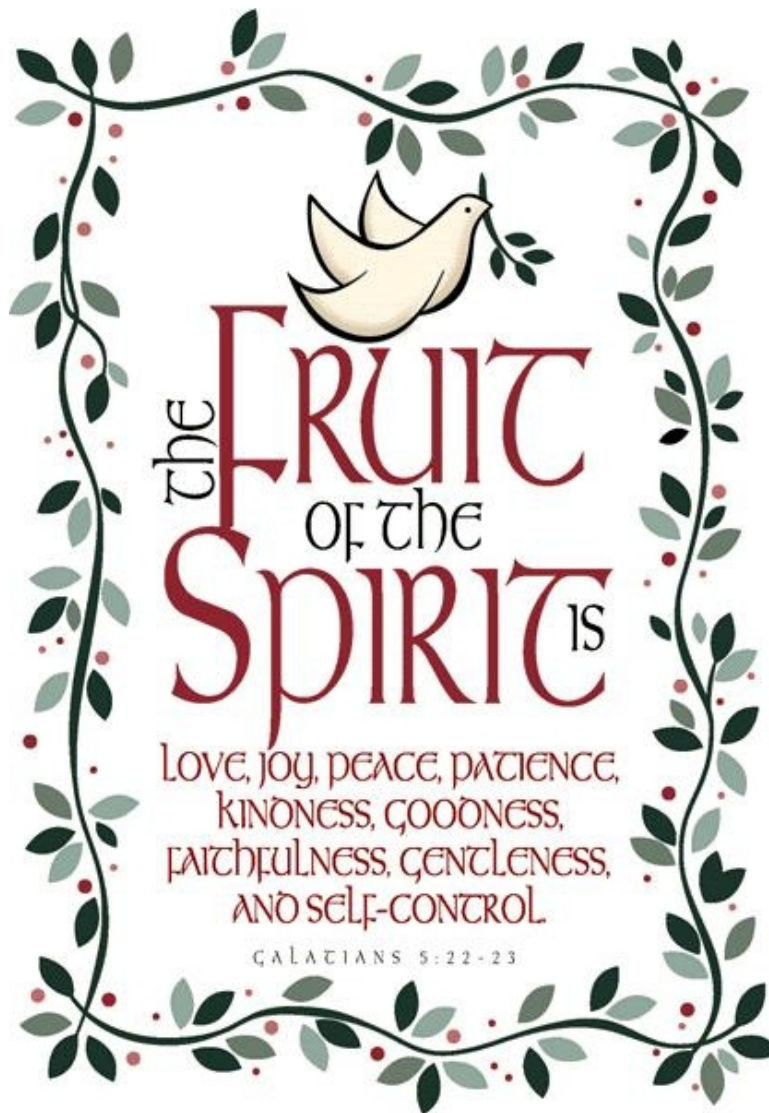
