Mike's Musings

How do we know we are Christians? Jesus in Chapter 14 in the book of John was trying to explain to his disciples that he was going to have to go, but that we need not worry he would someday return for all who follow him. He told them he was

going to his father's house to prepare a place for us. That is very comforting. Then he told them he was going to send the Holy Spirit to live within those who followed.
