How many times do we have to be told there are consequences for our sin. It happens way too many times, even to those who aren't really looking to do wrong. Why do we not learn very well? For one, the enemy (The Devil) does an absolutely great job of pushing our buttons and he knows how to distract us and tempt us.

We also assume that we can get away with sin or not be damaged by its consequences. Or we justify our behavior as being okay, not sinful. Here is an example from a recent trip my family took on our UTV's to Drummond Island. It was a fun time. Because we went with the younger dudes, you

could be sure we wouldn't take the easy route. When a big water hole presents itself, you go through it not around it. Well, we went through one too many water holes and my son in law buried his UTV and I avoided that hole, but the damage apparently had already been done and my UTV quit and wouldn't start. It was towed for about 30 minutes till we got to the beach. The end of the story was it finally started, and we enjoyed the rest of the day and by the way my son-in-law's UTV was winched out of the hole.

If I had avoided the previous water hole, I wouldn't have had the issue with needing a tow, but I yielded to temptation and paid a consequence (I must admit it was fun until my machine quit). The spiritual lesson here comes from Romans 7:15-17, 24-25a. "I do not understand what I do. For what I want to do I do not do, but what I hate to do. And if I do what I do not want to do, I agree that the law is good. As it is, it is no longer I myself who do it, but it is sin living in me." What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body of death? Thanks be to God – through Jesus Christ our Lord."

We could have avoided the water hole incident if we had heeded a sign that indicated the water hole was a deep one, but we took the plunge anyway. Isn't that just like sin? God warns us, the Holy Spirit warns us, The Bible warns us, but we jump anyway.

Let's learn from the warning signs in Scripture and let Jesus rescue us from ourselves. And when we don't heed his instructions, let's learn from our mistakes and do better the next time.
