I had been noticing lately that my iPhone was not charging very well in my truck. Finally, one day I tried to charge it and no matter what I tried, it wouldn't. I tried to diagnose what was going on, so I tried another cord but to no avail. It still wouldn't charge. I thought that perhaps my phone was at fault but when I plugged it in at home it worked. I then thought the port in the truck didn't work so I tried the other one too and it didn't work. At this point I was thinking the truck was the problem, but I didn't want to take it in to the dealer because of the cost. I tried one last thing! Buy a new cord for the truck. It worked.

Is there a spiritual lesson here. I think there is. Sometimes we are feeling disconnected to God, and we don't know why. Is it that God doesn't want to hear from us? No! Is it that God is not capable of answering our request? No! Eph. 3:20-21 says, "Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine...be glory." Elsewhere in Luke 1:37 it says, "nothing is impossible with God."

Is it because we can't connect with him because we aren't worthy? We aren't worthy but he considers us worthy. He forgave us and made us new creatures in Christ. Matthew 11:28 says, "Come to me all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest." He says, "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgives us sin and cleanse us of all unrighteousness." (1John 1:9).

The problem is sin! The cord was defective in my truck! I had to replace it. Sin separates us from God. Redeemed people have a new cord. They have experienced forgiveness because they accepted what was already offered. We are connected to God through Jesus Christ. He is the cord that connects us to God. Trust him and we stay connected. Trust ourselves and lose that dynamic connection with God.

Let God charge you up in Christ. Make sure you are plugged in. You will die spiritually without Him. He is your source of strength. The difference between the truck/phone/cord analogy and the one I just introduced is that the cord (Jesus) is never defective and is always plugged into God. Make sure He is your cord and make sure you are plugged in.
