

- 8:15 a.m. meet in the parking deck.
- <u>8:30 a.m.</u> depart together to assist family with safe and timely arrival to Yorktown.

Arrival at Yorktown and free parking options.

- 9:00 a.m. Three primary (free) parking locations.
  - Yorktown Battlefield Visitor Center, 1000 Colonial National Historic Pkwy, Yorktown, VA 23690
  - o Riverwalk Landing Parking Deck, 300 Water St, Yorktown, VA 23690
  - o Yorktown Beach Picnic Area, at the end of Water Street

After parking, walk to the corner of Water & Read Street. *Historic note*: According to the Blackwell Family Historian's research; this is the site where the slave ship Doddington disembarked Ama and Tab on June 18, 1735.

- 10:00 a.m. **Opening Ceremony**. Please arrive early enough for our large family group to get organized on the beach.
- Walking directions from the Visitor Center to the corner of Water & Read Street
  - o Take the walking trail to the left of the Visitor Center, cross the Footbridge, continue the trail.
  - o Continue straight on Main Street as you pass the Victory Monument to your right.
  - o Turn right at Read Street and walk down the hill.
  - o Gather on the other side of the street on the beach.
- Dropping off Elders and people with special accommodations
  - o Drop them off in the parking lot at the corner of Water & Read Street.
  - o Park if available, otherwise drop them off, and park in one of the above listed designated spots.
- The Trolly picks up from the Visitor Center and the Parking Deck every 20-35 minutes for free.

Movement from the corner of Water & Read Street to the Beach Picnic Area

- 11:00 a.m. Blackwell Family Reunion Cookout Style
- Walk down the Water Street sidewalk to the Beach Picnic Area
- Pick up elders and people with special considerations at the Water & Read Street parking lot, and drop them off in the parking lot of the Beach Picnic Area. We cannot reserve or block-off parking because this is a National Park.
  - o Tobacco Road Foot Trail is the most direct route to depart from the Picnic Area to the Visitor Center
