

Carol Connors - It started with a \$10 loan from her parents and went on to become one of the most important songs in Rock N' Roll history... and it was the reason Elvis Presley became her first boyfriend. He wanted to meet the girl who sang, *To Know Him Is To Love Him...* it was written by the infamous Phill Spector, and the group was the *Teddy Bears* and Carol Connors' voice captivated the world. She went on to be nominated for 10 major music awards – *Emmys, Grammys, Golden Globes and two Oscars*, one for co-writing the theme song for the movie *Rocky, Gonna Fly Now.* She was the only female to ever write a hot rod song, and it became #1 on the charts – *Hey Little Cobra* by the Rip Chords. She wrote the mega love song *With you I'm Born Again*, sung by Billy Preston & Syreeta. She also received an

honorary doctorate in fines arts and public service from the John F. Kennedy University. She has performed for Presidents and other notables throughout the country.



Merrie Lynn Ross - Starring in over 35 TV / films from portraying Marion Davis in a 13-hour *PBS mini-series, Julie Nixon* (president's daughter), Bubbles La Rue on *Happy Days* to Daytime's Emmy Soap Digest Award winner, as first daytime comedienne, Emma Lutz, on ABC's *General Hospital*- entertaining 30 million viewers with her contagious giggle and outrageous antics. Merrie Lynn produced the Cult classic *Class of 1984*, hit of the Cannes Film Festival, winning Best Picture Academy of Horror and Science Fiction. She received the Women in Films Director's Award for the docudrama, *Highjacker* profiling the foibles of being a police officer. Merrie Lynn's transformational book, *"Bounce off the Walls- Land on Your Feet*", is currently in release.

Jose H. Garofalo - A veteran filmmaker with extensive directing, writing and producing credits to his name. He has been in the film industry since 1978 in New York City and South Florida, working in various capacities on films such as *The Wanderers, Wolfen, Ghostbusters and Fort Apache -The Bronx.* He's written and directed various feature films such as *Redemption, The Wishing Stone, Sacred Waters and That's Livin'* featuring some of the industry's well known talent like Andy Garcia, Stephen Bauer, Rod Ball, Gloria Estefan, Arturo Sandoval and Al Sapienza among others. Today Jose continues to write, direct, produce and teach while working with the St. Lucie Film *Society* and the Treasure Coast International Film Festival to help develop the film industry in the area while promoting independent filmmakers and their

works of art to the community. He directed and co-produced tonight's docudrama feature *City Of Dreams*. He is a long-time resident of Port Saint Lucie.



Mark Barnes - Award winning composer and musician, Mark Barnes, provides a refreshing rush of chill out goodness, opening up amazing sound scapes that connect the ears and the mind's eye with lush melodies and organic wholeness often missing from the electronic realm. Barnes' music has been featured in numerous magazines, websites, compilation CD's, Local and National FM radio and On-line Radio Stations. He was a top finalist in the instrumental category for Unisong's 11th International Songwriting Contest. Additionally, Barnes was awarded the 2008 Independent National Artist of the year from the Phoenix Music Awards and was a performer as well as the recipient of the 2008 Hollywood F.A.M.E. Award for Music & Cinema at the 18th Annual LA Music Awards; the 2010 Composer of the Year at the 20th Annual LA Music Awards; and most

recently the recipient of the 2010 Genre Award in Music at the Pride in the Arts Music Awards sponsored by Rainbow World Radio. Barnes' music is featured throughout "City of Dreams" and he is credited with composing the music for the theme song for the film.



Robert Navarro - Born in New York City where he started his career as a pianist, arranger, producer, and therapeutic recreation therapist. Robert graduated from City College with a Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA) in Music. He attended Manners College of Music and Manhattan School of Music during his undergraduate years and later received his Master of Arts (MA) from New York University. Robert has worked with jazz greats Jackie Byrd, Harold Danko, John Lewis, Valerie Caper, Ed Summerlin & Ron Carter and studied classical piano with "Ms. Bagger". In 1997 he started his production company RNR Productions, Inc. He was a principle in the production of "Tipica 88 & Conjunto Classico" under the Warner Latina label which was nominated for a Latin American Grammy in 2004. In December 2007 he received a Grammy as an arranger with Bobby Cruz for his song "Envidia". Robert and his family moved to Port St. Lucie in 2007 where

he continues teaching guitar, piano, violin and music technology. He spends much of his time composing, producing, mixing, and mastering recordings. Robert did the arangement for the movie's theme song, "City Within A Dream."



Alana Ferraro - Got her start singing with Holy Family Young People's Choir (4 years), she has sung the National Anthem at the Mets Stadium and various other local events, and she sang solo and performed a duet with Carol Connors at last year's Treasure Coast Film Festival. In addition to singing, she enjoys musical theatre, having appeared in 13 productions at Port St. Lucie High School and 5 student productions at Pineapple Playhouse. "City of Dreams" is her first film credit. Alana is an eleventh grader at Port St. Lucie High School. When she graduates, she plans to pursue a college degree in musical theatre. Alana is the featured vocalist in the "City of Dreams" theme song, "City Within A Dream."



Nicky Wood - Has performed in 30 theatrical productions, appearing at venues from Miami to Los Angeles, but most often at the Maltz Jupiter Theatre and the McAlpin Fine Arts Center. He has done 3 films, 3 commercials, 2 television shows, and 2 voiceovers. He has also taken up writing and directing his own stage shows, having received a Congressional Award Silver Medal for his most recent production. He is currently working on his Congressional Award Gold Medal goals, which he plans to have completed by the end of this year.
