

**THAT THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF CLAYCOMO, MISSOURI, IS HEREBY AMENDED BY ADDING CHAPTER 12, ARTICLE II – FIRE DEPARTMENT, SECTION 12-27 – PERMITS.**

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CLAYCOMO, CLAY COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Chapter 12 – FIRE PREVENTION AND PROTECTION**

**ARTICLE II – FIRE DEPARTMENT**

**Section 12-27. Permits.**

**Section 12-27.1 Inspection required; Permits; Fees.**

- (a) Before a business license or permit is issued, the chief or fire code official shall cause an inspection and approve the receptacles, vehicles, building, devices, premises, storage spaces, or area to be used. In instances where laws or regulations are enforceable by departments other than the fire department, joint approval shall be obtained from all such concerned departments.
- (b) An operational permit shall remain in effect until reissued, renewed or revoked, or for a period of one (1) year as specified upon the permit. Permits are not transferable and any change in occupancy, operation, tenancy, or ownership shall require that a new permit be issued.
- (c) The Village shall charge a fee for issuance of permits pursuant to the following:
  - a. For the issuance of all operational permits except for those listed below .... No Charge
  - b. For the issuance of an explosives permit .... \$150.00
  - c. For the issuance of a fireworks display or pyrotechnic special effects material operational permits .... \$150.00
  - d. For the issuance of a hazardous materials' operational permits.... \$50.00
    - i. Aerosol Products – IFC 2018: 105.6.1
    - ii. Compressed gases – IFC 2018: 105.6.8
    - iii. Cryogenic fluids – IFC 2018: 105.6.10
    - iv. Flammable and combustible liquids – IFC 2018: 105.6.16
    - v. Hazardous Materials – IFC 2018: 105.6.20
    - vi. Hazardous Production Materials (HPM) – IFC 2018: 105.6.21
    - vii. Magnesium – IFC 2018: 105.6.28
    - viii. Pyroxylin plastics – IFC 2018: 105.6.41
    - ix. Spraying or dipping. – IFC 2018: 105.6.45

- e. The Fire Department may charge, in addition to other fees, a fee reflecting the direct costs for actions required to provide services related to permits.
