Drive-in picnic and road trip.....

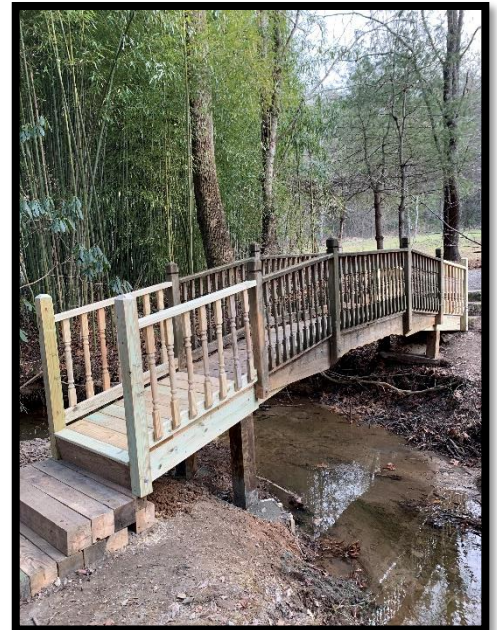


We had a little rain at the end of October.....BUT....
