The road maintenance fund took a major hit in 2018. The cost of plowing and repairs/road clearing due to the ice and snow storms totally depleted the fund. Money



from the general fund (active member



monies) had to be used to cover the expenses. We will have to look seriously at raising the road fee, especially if we have another winter like we did last year.

Steacy is working on revising the Association's budget and has taken steps to improve financial accountability. He updated the chart of accounts, created a balance sheet, and developed a year to date profit/loss statement. A revised budget will be approved by January 2020 so that we can get a better handle on our financial condition. There will also be an audit completed by an outside CPA.
