## In Memory of Nolan R. Gold

### Scholarship Application, 2024

The Nolan R. Gold Scholarship was established in 2017 to honor the memory of Nolan R. Gold, a graduate of Crown Point High School in 2015.

This scholarship will be awarded to a Crown Point High School graduating student that will be attending any four year college or university pursuing any bachelor degree.

**Award : \$6,000 +/-** (based on previous years)

#### Eligibility and Qualifications:

- Applicant must be a Crown Point High School student graduating in **June 2024**.
- Applicant must be graduating with Academic Honors.
- Applicant is attending any four year college or university pursuing any bachelor degree.
- Applicant must submit all requested information including application, reference letters, and official transcript by application deadline.
- Applicant must verify the accuracy of all information by signing the application.
- The application must be submitted on the form provided in the space provided; the final packet including the application, reference letters, and transcript needs to be placed in a large sealed envelope.
- Applicant must NOT be selected for a full scholarship from another source. If applicant is selected for a full scholarship, the applicant must forfeit this scholarship to the committee so that it can be awarded to the next eligible applicant.
- Awardees shall submit their receipts for expenses no later than **December 31, 2024**. All awards may be forfeited that have not been claimed by **December 31, 2024**.

#### References:

Two letters of reference are required. One should be from a teacher who has taught the applicant

in at least one class, and one should be from a member of the community or an extracurricular sponsor. Neither reference can be a family member. Both reference letters should be signed and returned to the applicant in sealed envelopes.
