## The Theodore W. Smith Art Scholarship Application, 2024

The Theodore W. Smith Art Scholarship was established in 2010 to honor the memory of Ted Smith, Class of 1969, who aspired in the arts in high school and through his lifetime.

The scholarship will be awarded to a gifted artist from the Class of 2024 who will be attending a post-secondary institution and pursuing a career in the art field.

*Application Deadline: March 15, 2024.*

### Application Guidelines

*Please read all application guidelines carefully and complete all portions fully and legibly.*

**Award: \$1,200.00**

#### **Eligibility and Qualifications:**

- Applicant must be a Crown Point High School senior who will graduate with his or her class in June of 2024 with the intent to study art in the academic year of 2024-2025.
- Applicant must compile a digital portfolio of 10-15 representative works – a **flash drive, Google drive link, etc...** with labeled digital images (.jpg files only). Also, include a complete typed inventory sheet of portfolio with application – size, media, titles, etc.
- Applicant must submit all requested information including application, reference letter, and official transcript, and **flash drive, Google drive link, etc...** portfolio with inventory sheet by the application deadline:  
**March 15, 2024.**
- Applicant must verify the accuracy of all information by signing the application.
- The application must be submitted on the form provided in the space provided; the application must be typed and stapled in the upper left corner, not placed in a binder; the final packet including application, reference letter, transcript, and **flash drive, Google drive link, etc...** portfolio with inventory sheet needs to be placed in a large sealed envelope.
- Applicant must NOT be selected for a FULL scholarship from another source. If applicant is selected for a FULL scholarship, the applicant must forfeit this scholarship to the committee so that it can be awarded to the next eligible applicant.
- Awardees' shall submit their receipts for expenses no later than **December 31, 2024**. All awards will be forfeited that have not been claimed by **December 31, 2024**.

**References:**

One letter of reference is required from the student's art teacher – one page, including the applicants list of characteristics. The reference letter should be signed by the art teacher and returned to the applicant in a sealed envelope.

**Application Deadline: March 15, 2024 to the Crown Point High School Guidance Office by the close of school that day.**

**Award Notification and Presentation:** The scholarship recipient will be notified at the Senior Awards ceremony  
**May 8, 2024**

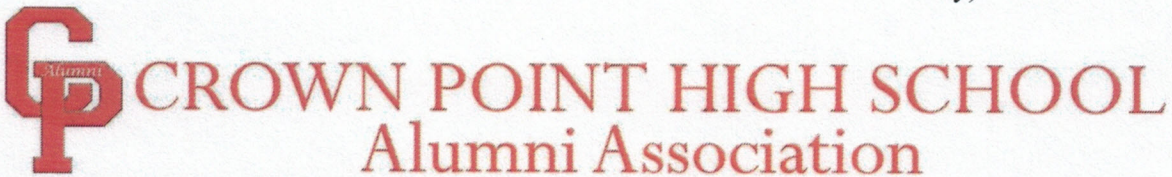
**Application Review:** Applications will be evaluated by the Theodore W. Smith Art Scholarship Review Committee, a designated subcommittee of the Crown Point High School Alumni Association.

**Final Application Checklist:**

- \_\_\_\_\_ 3. Does the final packet include a copy of the applicant's official transcript?
- \_\_\_\_\_ 4. Is the **flash drive, Google drive link, etc...** portfolio clearly labeled with the applicant's name and includes an inventory sheet?
- \_\_\_\_\_ 5. Are the short-answer essays written in a standard academic style, as expected for all academic work, and are they typed?
- \_\_\_\_\_ 6. Is the final packet clearly identifiable on the outside with the words: "Theodore W. Smith Art Scholarship Application"?
