River Length -249

Pool 10 located below Lock and dam 11

Date built- Lock 11 was built in 1904-06
Orientation: From Lock 11 we will travel downstream to lock 11. (R) will be the right bank of the river and (L) will be the left bank of the river.
Counties with River frontage in the pool: Estill, Madison, Clark
Length from lock& dam 10 to lock& dam 11 24.6 miles
Access points and directions <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • College Hill Ramp Madison Co, KY River Mile 109.8 (L) US52 east of Richmond to Waco; L on KY 977 to the River. • Gibson’s Red River Retreat, Clark Co. (Merrit) KY River mile 190.8 (R)- KY 89 S of Winchester to Trapp, R on Red River Road , stay on Ferry Rd to the River. • Jackson Ferry Ramp, KY River Mile 185.5, KY 974 SE of Winchester , six miles, R on Muddy Creek rd to River. • Happy Hour Boar Dock and Marina (Ford Ramp), Clark Co. KY River Mile 179.3 (R), KY 627 S of Winchester, L on old KY 627 L Ford Hampton Road to the River. • Lock 10 *(L) future site of portages
Points of interest: (floating assessment) Below lock 11 (L) Just below the Lock and dam. Popular fishing right off the shore. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • *Mile 201.0 (R) future site of portages and park. • Mile 201. Below lock and dam 11 large natural beach area (L) great rest stop and picnic area. • Mile 200 (R) Rocky Shoreline • Mile 199.8 (L) Lick Run • Mile 199.1 (L) Noland Creek • Mile 198.9 (L) Raven Run with beach area, rest stop and picnic. • Mile 198.6 (L) Nolan Creek Bar, and rocky beach. Rest stop and picnic. • Mile 197-198 Rock cliffs and over hangs. • Mile 196 (R) Cow Run Creek • Mile 195.5 (R) Palisades • Mile 194.5-192.5 Rock Cliffs. • Mile 192-191 (R) Rock Face • Mile 190.9 (R) Red River, follow it to Red River gorge! Paddle all year! And Gibson’s ramp (Merrit)and camping. • Mile 190.8 (L) College Hill Boat ramp, Madison Co. Good Place for a rest stop and picnic. Great access and parking. • Mile 188.6 (L) Bull Run • Mile 187.8 (R) Noname Creek • Mile 187 (R) Upper Howard Creek, Aerial Power lines. • Mile 185.5 Jackson Ferry Boat Ram • Mile 184.9 (L) Muddy Creek • Mile 184.6 (R) Shoal rest area and picnic • Mile 184 (R) Indian Creek

- Mile 181.7 (L) Bar Run
- Mile 180.4 Four Mile Creek

- Mile 179.4 (R) Two mile Creek, (R)Happy Hour ramp and marina.
- Mile 177.5 RR Bridge, Ford, Dale Power plant
- Mile 177.4 (L) Otter Creek, probable site of the original stockade of Boonesborough
- Mile 176.7 (R) Closed private ramp & boat dock.
- Mile 176 Lock and Dam 10, restricted area! Loc and dam just ahead! This is a low head dam and blends in to the horizon! Watch out for the restricted area 500 feet from the dam. The lock is located to the left.
- *Future portage with access will also be on the (L)

Brief description of pool

Pool 10 is a 24.6 mile paddle with a few natural beaches and beautiful views. The rock cliffs are spectacular. The Tree lined river is home to a host of wildlife. It is very remote undeveloped and a real getaway adventure.
