- Ravenna American Legion Ramp- Estill Co., KY River mile 221.2 (R) KY 52 E of Irvine to Ravenna 1 mile
- Lock 12 (closed) Estill Co, KY River mile 220.9 (R)

**Points of interest: (floating assessment)** The lock 13 ramp is located (L) Just below the Lock and dam. Popular fishing right off the shore.

- \*Mile 239 (L) future site of portages and park.
- Mile 239.9 ("L) Ramp, concrete and easy access with parking.
- Mile 238.5 Aerial Power Lines
- Mile 236.5 (L) Bridge piers
- Mile 236. (L) Shoals could be a good rest stop.
- Mile 231.6 Old Landing
- Mile 230 Aerial Power Lines
- Mile 227.5 Aerial Power Lines and on the (L) Buck Creek
- Mile 225.5 (R) Miller Creek with beach. Good rest stop.
- Mile 225 (L) Blue Lick Branch

- Mile 223 (R) Ravenna American Legion ramp
- Mile 222.4 (L) Wagers Bend and shoals and beach, good rest stop.
- Mile 222 (L) Shale cliff

- Mile 221 Lock and dam 12, Restricted area! Loc and dam just ahead! This is a low head dam and blends in to the horizon! Watch out for the restricted area 500 feet from the dam. The lock is located to the right.
- \*Future portage with access will also be on the (R)

### **Brief description of pool**

Pool 12 is a 19 mile paddle with a few natural beaches and beautiful views. The Tree lined river is home to a host of wildlife. It is very remote undeveloped and a real getaway adventure. Always take out more trash than you bring in! Practice good stewardship!
