Date built- Lock 14 was built in 1911-17
Orientation: From Lock 14 we will travel downstream to lock 13. ( $R$ )will be the right bank of the river and ( $L$ ) will be the left bank of the river.

Lock 14 Ramp- KY mile 249, concrete,
KY 11 S. of Beattyville, R on KY 587, R on Ky399, R on Spencer Bridge, R on Evelyn Rd to the river

## Points of interest: (floating assessment)

The sturgeon Boat Ramp is right below the Spencer Bridge(Blue Bridge). This is the only public access to pool 13. This is one of the shortest pools in length so it is easily paddled for a day trip. The Heidelberg park is just on the other side of the blue bridge.

## Brief description of pool

There are lots of little beaches and shoals that make great rest stops and picnic areas. It will depend on the water level for a few. The Palisades and rock cliffs are beautiful. There is very little development so the paddlers experience is very peaceful. There is a park located just on the other side of the blue bridge. Always take out more trash than you bring in! Practice good stewardship!
