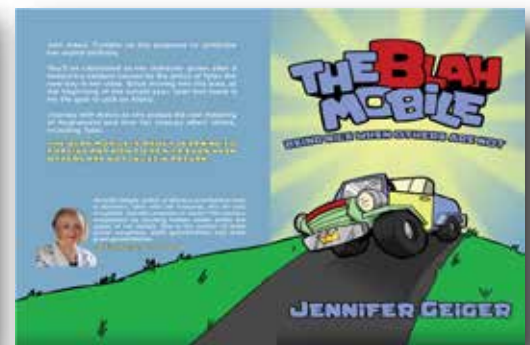
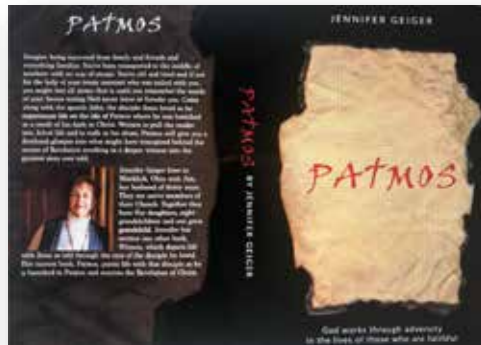

About The Blah Mobile

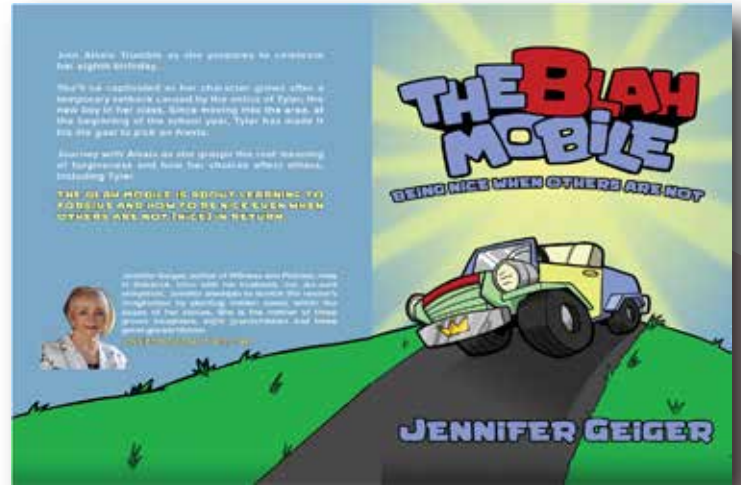
