

- 1. Use Black or Blue Ink to mark the ballot.
- 2. Completely fill in the empty oval to the left of the candidate name or choice in all races you wish to vote.
- 3. If voting for a Write-In candidate, completely fill in the oval to the left of the Write-In selection, then write the name of the Write-In candidate in the space provided.

Warning

- Do NOT use red ink or felt tip pen to mark ballot.
- Do <u>NOT</u> circle, underline or mark through choices. Do <u>NOT</u> use check marks or X to mark ballot.
- Do NOT mark more choices per race than allowed.
- Do <u>NOT</u> sign, cut, tear or damage the ballot.

If you make a mistake or change your mind on a selection:

A. Do not attempt to mark through the selection or attempt to erase. Write "Spoiled" across the ballot AND across the return envelope.

B. Mail or return the spoiled ballot and envelope to your county board of registrars; a new official absentee ballot will be mailed to you.

If you decide to vote in-person: Surrender the ballot to the poll manager at an early voting site within your county or the precinct to which you are assigned. You will then be permitted to vote a regular ballot.

Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax for Education (ESPLOST)

(Vote for One)

Shall the special 1 percent sales and use tax for education currently in effect in Chattahoochee County be continued on January 1, 2026, or upon the earlier expiration of the tax now in effect, for a period of time not to exceed 20 consecutive calendar quarters to raise not more than \$6,500,000 for the following educational purposes: (a) paying previously incurred general obligation debt, revenue bond debt, and/or lease purchase or installment sale agreement payments at a maximum cost of \$5,372,940; and (b) (i) planning for a new school building; and (ii) acquiring, constructing, repairing, improving, renovating, adding to, extending, upgrading, furnishing, and/or equipping school buildings, and athletic facilities, and/or acquiring transportation vehicles and/or equipment, and/or infrastructure in the Chattahoochee County School District useful or desirable in connection therewith, including acquiring any necessary property therefore, both real and personal (the "Projects") at a maximum cost of \$1,127,060?
