2022 Kansas Quarter Horse Association Show Approval Process

The Kansas Quarter Horse Association owns the following shows:

- KQHA Prairie Classic/Ok City, OK
- KQHA Let It Ride Circuit
- KAQHA Celebrating Kansas Circuit
- KQHA Hope In The Heartland

All other shows and special events, while approved for KQHA points, are owned by other individuals/groups.

For an AQHA show or special event to be approved for KQHA year-end points the following criteria must be met:

- 1. KQHA will not approve new shows held on the same dates as shows already approved by KQHA the previous year.
- 2. A KQHA Sanction request and the \$100.00 fee must be submitted to the Association 120 days in advance of the first day of the show for the show to be approved for year-end points.
- 3. AQHA membership, show and contest rules and regulations shall prevail at all KQHA approved shows.
- 4. Every exhibitor must have a current individual AQHA membership.
- 5. Each show committee, manager or secretary is required to send a complete copy of the show results to KQHA within ten (10) days after the show. Computer copies or clear legible photocopies of AQHA show results are acceptable. Any show in violation of this rule will be charged the cost to KQHA of securing results from AQHA and will not be approved by KQHA the following year.
- 6. Each KQHA approved show is required to submit a year-end award fee of one dollar (\$1.00) per open, amateur, youth and novice entry to the KQHA office. Future KQHA show approval will be contingent upon receipt of this fee.
