At this time, anyone desiring to join virtually is able to view and/or listen only through a privately purchased program and personal equipment. A program for virtual access has to be decided upon and equipment purchased. The position of access technician should be created. No protocols have yet been established for input of any kind. If you are a computer guru or have an idea or suggestion to enable secure participation virtually, please send it to me via email, postal mail, or even a telephone call.

In addition to sharing information in a timely manner, the ability to provide access for our elderly, infirm, or disabled members will surely promote and reinforce our Marine Corps brotherhood.

If you did not receive an invoice, please let me now.

**REMINDER:** Annually on or about July 1<sup>st,</sup> an invoice will be sent to each Detachment/Unit/Pack and Pound for the annual dues.

We are continuing to update the email address list for those who wish to receive the Illinois Marine via email. If you are receiving this publication via hardcopy and have email, please consider requesting it by email. Each hardcopy mailed out costs the Department on average 85 to 95 cents. Any reduction of postage expenses benefits the Department of Illinois's budget. I would ask that a list of all "New" members with Name, Address and email, if available, be submitted to the editor to facilitate addition to the mailing or email list.

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
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
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#### The Marines' Prayer


#### **OATH OF ENLISTMENT AND OFFICE** (Oh so long ago for some of us)

The Oath of enlistment is something that every service member must promise and adhere to for his/her entire military career. From the Oath, you can see that you will be defending the Constitution - not a person. Discipline and accepting orders is sworn to. Finally, you vow to face the UCMJ (Uniform Code of Military Justice) should any disputes arise.

The Oath of Enlistment (for enlisted): "I, \_\_\_\_\_, do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will support and defend the Constitution of the United States against all enemies, foreign and domestic; that I will bear true faith and allegiance to the same; and that I will obey the orders of the President of the United States and the orders of the officers appointed over me, according to regulations and the Uniform Code of Military Justice. So help me God."

The Oath of Office (for officers): "I, \_\_\_\_\_ (SSAN), having been appointed an officer in the \_\_\_\_\_ (Military Branch) of the United States, as indicated above in the grade of \_\_\_\_\_ do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will support and defend the Constitution of the United States against all enemies, foreign or domestic, that I will bear true faith and allegiance to the same; that I take this obligation freely, without any mental reservations or purpose of evasion; and that I will well and faithfully discharge the duties of the office upon which I am about to enter; So help me God." Before you raise your right hand, make sure you understand what you are swearing or attesting to. The oath of enlistment should not be taken lightly, you will be bound by it for the next 4 to 6 years at a minimum.





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
