## SEMINAR DESCRIPTION:

This program takes a detailed look at the criteria set forth in ANSI and ASTM standards that establish the visual, physical, and performance requirements for the various types of ceramic tile. The program examines tile's aesthetic classifications, its dimensional stability, and other factors that impact the appearance of the finished assembly. It also looks at the physical criteria of strength, water absorption, resistance to scratching, impact, and other loads, slip resistance, and other physical criteria set forth in the standards. Finally, the program looks at the performance of the finished tile assembly and how the visual and physical properties work in concert to provide a beautiful, durable, and versatile finish that will last for generations.

## ABOUT THE PRESENTER:

Scott Conwell has been with IMI for 25 years. He sits on the Tile Marble Terrazzo craft committee of the International Union of Bricklayers and Allied Craftworkers, the TCNA Handbook Committee, and the ANSI A108 Committee for Ceramic Tile. He is a Fellow of the American Institute of Architects and the Construction Specifications Institute.
