

**The Dressage Advisory Committee would like to clarify with the following additions to the
CEA DC 2020
(October 13, 2020)**

Warm Up For the Competition

1. Due to Covid 19 restrictions many countries will have their competition at the various participating stables. Some of these stables have only one riding arena that will have to serve as the warm up and competition arena. The Judge and the Dressage Advisory Committee have granted these countries permission to warm up in their competition arena. All other rules will apply.
2. In those countries who have separate warm up and competition arenas, they may give each rider a "grace time" in the competition arena.

FEI Intermediate 2

1. Since there is no FEI Freestyle for those riders competing in the CEA FEI Intermediate 2 test the Judge and the Dressage Advisory Committee have granted these riders permission to use the FEI Intermediate A/B (edition 2018) as their Freestyle test.

CEA DC Rule 2.12 B ----A horse may go twice with 2 riders in 2 separate classes, also conservative

1. Once again because of Covid 19 and countries hosting a number of shows to complete their leg of the CEA Dressage Challenge the Judge and the Dressage Advisory Committee have granted permission for a horse to be ridden by two different riders in two separate classes that are not consecutive.
2. Please note the following applies
 - If the horse is being ridden for a team eligibility that said horse and rider combination must be first in the arena no matter how many shows are hosted to complete a country's leg.
 - If the horse is ridden in 2 separate classes that are not consecutive these rides must be completed on separate days.
