## *Veteran's Day – Ceremonial Flag Burning Service*

The November Rally Host Group will hold a ceremonial flag burning service at 5 PM on Thursday, November 11 at the TAHI Inspiration Point.

The American Legion passed a resolution about flag retirement ceremonies in 1937, and the approved method of disposing of unserviceable flags has long been that they be destroyed by burning. 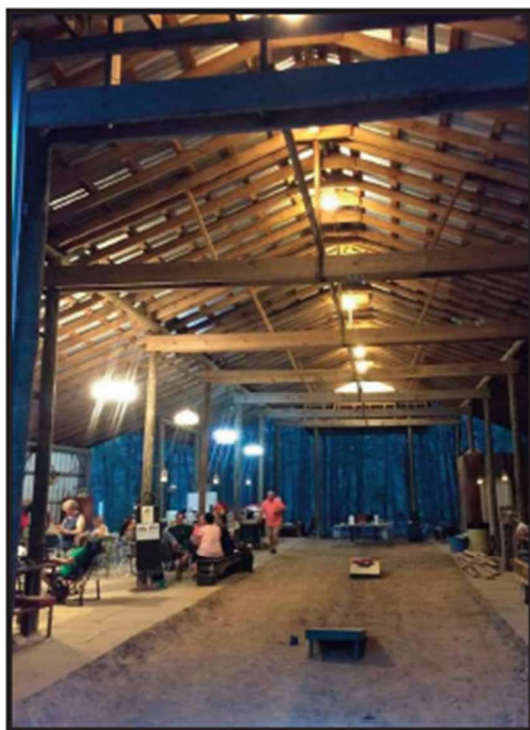

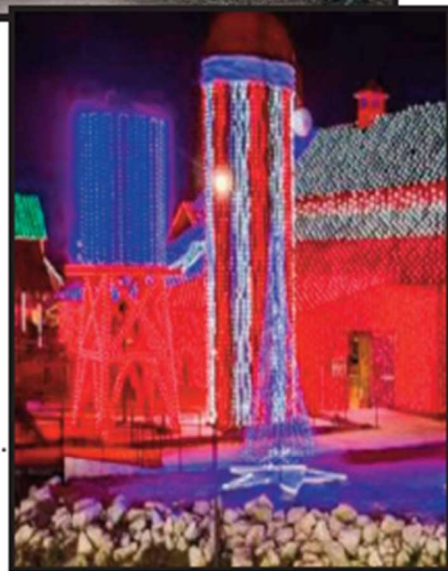
