

TOPSoccer FAQ

1. If I want to be a buddy or coach for my child do I have to complete the background check, fingerprinting and take the online classes?

Anyone over 18 MUST complete these requirements prior to participating. This is a condition from Cal North.

2. If you were registered to be a coach for the 2023 Fall season of WYSL do I have to do another background check, fingerprinting or take the online classes?

NO. All of this is good until our next fall season.

3. What do we bring to the clinic sessions?

Please remember to bring water and closed-toe shoes to each session. A jersey will be provided to each player for them to keep. Please try to remember to bring it each session even if they can not wear it. Also, please try to have your child use the restroom prior to coming as bathroom facilities can become busy.

4. What if I don't have a family member or friend to be a buddy for my player?

We will provide your player with a buddy.

5. Will everyone have their own buddy?

We will try our hardest to have one buddy to one player.

6. How will players be divided into teams?

Players will be divided primarily by abilities but also by age if necessary. Please let us know if there are any concerns.

7. What if I want to help but I don't know anything about soccer?

You do not need to know anything about soccer to be able to volunteer. We will go over a game plan for each week and have other coaches that are experienced in soccer around to help answer any questions. The goal is for everyone to have fun.

8. What if I can't attend all 6 sessions?
