

With two repeaters connected to the internet via Echolink it is possible for mobile users to have international QSO's via their 2m or 70cm radios. Links to HF are also possible subject to regulations. I have used Echolink for several QSO's - interesting.

FCC Upholds Rights of NA1RA Repeater on 146.730

Acting on a request initiated by James, KE1AI, the FCC has recognized that the NA1RA repeater operating on 146.730 and licensed to the Northville Amateur Radio Association was appropriately coordinated by CSMA and has preference to operate on that frequency. The FCC has asked that the repeater operation of W2KGY, operating on the same frequency from a location near West Point and interfering with the NA1RA repeater, take action to minimize or eliminate that interference. The FCC further criticized the UNYREPCO coordinating entity in New York for not taking appropriate coordinating action with CSMA before giving the OK to NA1RA to operate on the same frequency, Kudos to James, KE1AI for pursuing the matter with the FCC, and for the FCC for doing the right thing.

FCC Proposes Hike in Vanity Call Sign Fees.

The FCC has proposed increasing the regulatory fee to apply for, renew, or reinstate an Amateur Radio call sign, from \$14.50 to \$16.30, effective this fall.
