CARA Meeting Minutes for June 11, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 8 PM by President Frank Etzler, N8WXQ, with 18 members present.

The program for the evening was the final organization of Field Day led by Chairman Jamie Mullis, KB1MQB. As part of the presentation John Ahle, W1JMA, demonstrated the N3FJP logging software that we will be using.

Other Field Day items that came up during our discussion were:

At present the Field Day antennas and other equipment are stored at several locations. We now have a locked room at the Bethel EOC where everything could be brought together and we are finalizing these arrangements. Several CARA members have keys to the room so in an emergency we could quickly be up and running.

We are considering a new location for Field Day at Putnam State Park on the Bethel/Redding town line. There is a large open area bordered by large trees that could be used to anchor antennas. More important, unlike Cadigan Park, this site has minimum RFI.

Finally, as we conduct Field Day, look around and think about what equipment would be good to have in the future.

At the start of the business meeting, the Secretary's report and the Treasurer's report of \$9,950.34 were each accepted.

As called for in the Candlewood Amateur Radio Association Constitution, Article II, Section 4, the election of club officers for the coming year was held at this meeting.



Conditions, at least on the East Coast, were quite good. Operators at W1AW, the Hiram Percy Maxim Memorial Station, worked almost 3000 stations during Field Day, including a few California stations on 6 and 10 meters, as well as North Dakota on 10 meters on Saturday. Don't forget to send in your Field Day logs. Logs for 2010 ARRL Field Day must be postmarked, e-mailed to the ARRL, posted to the Field Day Web Submission Applet site or submitted by 2059 UTC Tuesday, July 27, 2010. Late entries cannot be accepted. You can also post your Field Day stories and photos on the Field Day Soapbox. The 2011 ARRL Field Day will be June 25-26.
