on *Windows* operating systems. Instructions to uninstall *Adobe® AIR™* 3.8 and re-install version 3.7 can be found on the "Save to Desktop" page through digital *QST*:

If prompted to upgrade *Adobe® AIR™* to version 3.8, click "No."

If already upgraded and experiencing issues with *Adobe® AIR™*, uninstall and reinstall an older version.

To remove *Adobe® AIR™* using Windows:

- Select Start > Settings > Control Panel.
- Open the Add or Remove Programs panel.
- Select *Adobe® AIR™* to remove the runtime.
- Click the Change/Remove button.


