Attachment "A" To the Scholarship Non-Endowment Fund Agreement between the Community Foundation of Ellis And Sybil Luea Luea Scholarship

Scholarship Criteria and Requirements are as follows:

- 1. Applicant must be a graduate of Ellis High School and attending any Kansas postsecondary campus pursuing a degree in agriculture field.
- 2. Applicants must have earned at least a cumulative 2.5 GPA from Ellis High School.
- 3. The following should be included in the application.
 - a. Application form completed.
 - b. Statement of 500 words or less describing educational goals and future agriculture plans.
 - c. Two letters of recommendation (signed originals) from a non-family member such as teacher, community member, or employer.
 - d. Resume detailing activities and achievements.
 - e. Copy of most recent transcript.
 - f. Please list any other scholarships, grants, etc. that you have been awarded and will be accepting.

The Luea Scholarship is a non-endowed scholarship fund. The donor elects to utilize the Internal Review Team of the Community Foundation of Ellis. Said review team will review the completed applications and make a recommendation of the recipient to the board of directors of the Community Foundation of Ellis for final review and approval accordingly.

Scholarship amounts vary depending on the degree/program the recipient is seeking and continues if the recipient pursues an agriculture degree/program. Renewals of \$500 per semester will be awarded while earning a four-year bachelor's degree, a two-year associate degree or short-term program less than 24 months. Programs less than twelve months will receive a one-time \$500 scholarship.

All supporting documentation must be provided before March 31 of each year to be considered. Late applications will not be accepted.

Notifications: Scholarship recipients will be notified by the Community Foundation of Ellis. EHS Senior recipients will be announced at the annual EHS Awards Assembly.
