There was a brief discussion by Steve Stuart and Tim Kellett listing the criteria set forth by DWR. This item will be discussed in further detail at the August meeting.

E. Discussion Regarding the Recharge Opportunities, Commitment, and Strategies by Water Retailers for Utilizing Imported Water Groundwater Recharge

There was a brief discussion that projects are being planned with multiple agencies for groundwater recharge. The group was looking for guidance on how DWR will

view these projects. Several agencies would like to discuss potential projects in the future.

F. Status Report on the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act Grant and Financial Status

Tim Kellett discussed the grant administration process. Tim Kellett is to prepare an April progress report for the grant.




