# Nehemiah 12:27, 30-31, 38, 43-47

27 And at the dedication of the wall of Jerusalem they sought the Levites in all their places, to bring them to Jerusalem to celebrate the dedication with gladness, with thanksgivings and with singing, with cymbals, harps, and lyres.

30 And the priests and the Levites purified themselves, and they purified the people and the gates and the wall. 31 Then I brought the leaders of Judah up onto the wall and appointed two great choirs that gave thanks. One went to the south on the wall to the Dung Gate.

38 The other choir of those who gave thanks went to the north, and I followed them with half of the people, on the wall, above the Tower of the Ovens, to the Broad Wall,

43 And they offered great sacrifices that day and rejoiced, for God had made them rejoice with great joy; the women and children also rejoiced. And the joy of Jerusalem was heard far away.

44 On that day men were appointed over the storerooms, the contributions, the firstfruits, and the tithes, to gather into them the portions required by the Law for the priests and for the Levites according to the fields of the towns, for Judah rejoiced over the priests and the Levites who ministered. 45 And they performed the service of their God and the service of purification, as did the singers and the gatekeepers, according to the command of David and his son Solomon. 46 For long ago in the days of David and Asaph there were directors of the singers, and there were songs of praise and thanksgiving to God. 47 And all Israel in the days of Zerubbabel and in the days of Nehemiah gave the daily portions for the singers and the gatekeepers; and they set apart that which was for the Levites; and the Levites set apart that which was for the sons of Aaron.

# Nehemiah 12:27-47

Things to Celebrate in Nehemiah:

- Nehemiah got permission from Artaxerxes.
- · Nehemiah had a plan to rebuild.
- Nehemiah energized a dispirited people.
- Nehemiah overcame tremendous obstacles.
- Nehemiah completed the wall in 5 days.
- Nehemiah encouraged a revival in Israel.
- Nehemiah successfully repopulated the city.

These were genuine reasons for a celebration. Even the celebration included planning and specific things:

# I. Purification

Nehemiah cited that the priests and Levites go through \_\_\_\_\_\_\_. What would have been the greatest obstacle to their worship? It is the same for us today. Psalm 24:4 states that the one who enters the presence of God must do so with \_\_\_\_\_\_ and a \_\_\_\_\_\_. During Jesus' day, the pharisees appeared to be the most holy of all people but Jesus had another opinion. I wonder if the evangelical church has gone so far that we do not see worship as an encounter with the Holy God of Heaven?

#### II. Music

You note in our passage that music played a significant role in the celebration, including instruments. For centuries there has been debate about their usage. The focus of our singing must be God and His Glory.

#### II. Gratitude

The celebration was exuberant and joyful. Just like someone who has been greatly forgiven tends to offer that forgiveness quickly and fully, someone who understands the being of God, His grace and mercy, will be filled with gratitude.

# III. Giving

This trait always accompanies people who are committed to worship and gratitude for God. These Israelites understood their giving went beyond the legal requirement of 10%.

Each of these things was done in community....
