Trusting the LORD in 2024 Romans 8:26-38

There are 5 Undeniable Declarations in our passages this and next week. What shall we say to Romans 8:29-30?

I. If God is for Us, Who Can Be Against Us?

II. How Will He Not Also Give Us All Things?

Maybe we've doubted our standing with the LORD, doubting even our salvation. Perhaps you think God has had enough of you and you're failing to obey? Allow me to remind us that the Father spared nothing to redeem His people, not even His Son. Is 53:10, II Cor 5:21. It was "on our behalf" that He bore our sin in His own body. If He's already given His Son, will He withhold anything from us to fulfill our glorification?

If we need strength to overcome temptation?

What if we need a friend in times of sadness/grief.

How about when we pass into eternity?

Have we been overlooked by God?

III. Who Shall Bring Any Charge Against God's Elect?
