## I. The Departure of the Crowd

Preaching a hard sermon....

It's hard to follow Jesus...

The line between true and false disciples is the teaching of Biblical Truth.

#### II. The Question From Jesus

He wasn't bothered by the departures...

He didn't dilute his teaching.

You don't want to go away, do you?

## III. The Response of Peter

It was not the supernatural works of Jesus but His Words that captivated the Twelve.

The 5 Solas of the Reformation

Sola Scriptura – Scripture Alone Sola Fide – Faith Alone

Sola Gratia - Grace Alone Soli Deo Gloria Glory to God Alone

SOLUS CHRISTUS - Christ Alone

Seeing is believing?

Assurance, insight and knowledge are the fruit of believing God's Word.

### IV. The Grace of God

Peter, in answering Jesus' question sounded a bit arrogant. Jesus did not want Peter taking credit for his salvation. John 6:44, 6:65. You don't want fairness and justice before a Holy God....you want \_\_\_\_\_.

### V. The Rebuke of Judas

διαβολος - diabolos. It's translated "slanderer, false accuser in common Greek but in the NT, it's Satan.

Jesus said this one year before the crucifixion. It was a hypocrite and false apostle whom he called a devil.

The choice of Judas....

Displayed the perfections of Jesus, revealed a solemn warning for a sinner, Judas' presence shows us we may expect to find hypocrites among Jesus' followers.

One made a great confession, another was disturbingly revealed....
