Dan Pottner is Human Resources Coordinator at Arctic Barnabas ministries. When Dan was twelve, he experienced God's power and protection during a tornado while fishing with his dad and brother. He knew God was real and had personally kept him from harm that day, yet he continued to live life his own way for the next 20 years. His failed attempts to find fulfillment left him feeling empty and hopeless. He had nowhere left to go. In September of 1998, He got down on his knees and told God that if He could show himself as real and would change his life, Dan would follow Him forever. He did and a few months later Dan met Juli.

Juli grew up in a Christian home and accepted Christ as a child. She had an interest in missions since she was a kid and wanted to be a missionary to Africa. (That's where she thought you had to go.) Over the past 12 years felt called to serve God in a full-time capacity.
