## Landscape

- Dry Season Adjustment- The timers have been changed due to the CDD regulations for watering 1 day a week.

#### Maintenance

- Gazebo Carejack cannot make the repairs. Megan provided contacts for some people that might be able to make the repairs.
- Paver Repair Carejack was able to re-lay the uneven pavers for \$305.
- Woodpecker Season The coating that can be applied to the houses works, the board has agreed that in the next newsletter there will be recommendations. The clear plastic coverings at 3601 will be replaced after PLCA approval.

## Unfinished Business

- Covenant Compliance- Driveway & Roof Power Washing
  - Pelican Landing will be looking for noncompliance across the entire community.

### **New Business**

- 1. Resident 3605 Bruce Osterink
  - Mr. Osterink asked the board to reconsider the amount previously approved by the board of \$1000 for landscape reimbursement and increase it to \$2,200.
  - The Board discussed; it was determined that they will keep the previous motion and not increase the amount.
- 2. CDD trim policy change
  - There is a new person, Paul Kemp, in charge of the landscaping at the CDD. He has told residents the CDD does not maintain the Pelican Nest Drive landscape or the reserve area behind the houses. The board asked Green Acres to maintain what the CDD is no longer maintaining. However, contractors and residents are not permitted to enter the reserve areas as they are tortoise preserves.
