

UAL PERFORMING & PRODUCTION ARTS

WHO IS THIS COURSE FOR?

This brand-new course is ideal for enthusiastic 16-18s who want to work with industry professionals to learn and develop contemporary musical theatre performance skills.

WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW?

What previous experience or qualifications will I need?

For Level 2: You do not need any previous qualifications, you just need to be enthusiastic towards your studies.

For Level 3: Ideally you should have successfully achieved 3 GCSEs at Grade 4 or above, one preferably in Performing Arts; or completed a Level 2 qualification.

English and maths are a desired necessity for numerous professional jobs, as well as for higher education courses you may wish to progress on to. If you achieve below a grade 4 in your English and/or maths at GCSE, TMP will provide the opportunity to study whichever one you require alongside your main vocational course.

How will I know I have achieved?

Learners and tutors will develop an individual learning plan, which will record what you have achieved over the course.

How will I be assessed?

Tutors will plan assessment activities, which will form the basis of each project. This is a vocational course with no exams and as a result has a practical focus, which means you will mainly be assessed on your performance skills through practical exploration. Supporting material will be either in written form of in a format that will suit each individual learner and this will be assessed alongside the practical work.

Where can I go next?

Level 2: If studying a Level 2 diploma, learners will have the opportunity to progress onto our Level 3 courses. Level 3: This qualification will allow learners to progress onto University or Drama School, which can then lead to a career in the Performing Arts.

What do I need to bring?

No specialist equipment required, but comfortable clothing that learners can move freely in is recommended. However, learners are encouraged to bring a pen, pencil and notebook to every session in order to make notes on techniques learned and to annotate scripts.



MATHS & ENGLISH

WHAT IF YOU DON'T PASS?

Maths and English is a very important aspect of your future no matter what industry you may find yourself in as employers and universities require you to have a grade 4 GCSE equivalent.

However, don't worry if you haven't achieved your grade 4 in school or college yet as we offer a range of options to complete your maths and English as part of your creative programme. If you have achieved a grade 3 at GCSEs in maths and/or English, you will be able to retake your GCSEs with TMP. There are two opportunities in the year in November and May. If you have achieved a grade 2 or less in maths and/or English GCSE, you will be able to take your functional skills exams. These can be taken whenever you are ready and you can start at entry level and work your way up until you have your level 2 which is the equivalent of a GCSE grade 4.

EHCP LEARNING SUPPORT

At TMP College we pride ourselves on our diverse range of teaching and learning delivery methods and strategies. We understand that not everyone will learn in the same way, at the same pace or in the same environments.

Therefore we priorities everyone's learning needs at the initial stages of meeting new learners and parents to develop an atmosphere within classrooms that meet these needs.

We work with many different local authorities within the North West of England to ensure there is sufficient learning support in place for anyone with an Education Health Care Plan. We also will assist in organizing transportation, travel training, chaperoning and other care needs alongside a learner's creative education.

TMP College hosts optionally PFA (preparation for adulthood) sessions at the end of each week to develop independent skills for learners who identify areas within their skillsets that need improvement. These can include sessions such as textiles, healthy living, DIY, self-defense, understanding budgets, developing social skills and more.

We are very proud of our learner's journeys and constant progress shown with a big thanks to our pastoral and wellbeing team. TMP is Matrix Accredited in providing professional information, advice and guidance.



LEARNING SUPPORT

At TMP we're proud to have an extensive department of learning support tutors that are trained in supporting young people as well as having creative skills and backgrounds to provide technical support as well as emotional and wellbeing. Our support team are TMPs biggest assets in meeting the needs of all learners and guiding them to a successful and positive experience whilst at TMP.

We understand how overwhelming it can be starting a new college with new people and information so we make sure that each learner has a smooth transition to us by working with learners, parents and local authorities across the North West of England. We do this by offering taster days, open evenings and informal meetings to walk around college, chat to tutors and support staff so that new learners are able to decide if TMP is right for them. Following this, we can then begin to prepare support needs such as transportation, travel training, getting to know and understand each learner, take part in workshops and taster days to meet a handful of the new class at a time over the summer holidays etc. Our pastoral and wellbeing team work with learners throughout the year to ensure they have all the support they require each step of the way. We also have learner counselling available and intervention team should any learners have any issues arise or barriers that they need need help and support with.

WORK EXPERIENCE & SUPPORTED INTERNSHIPS


