Miriam L. Freimer, MD is a professor of Neurology at the Ohio State University. She has been the director of the Neuromuscular Division for over 9 years. She attended the Ohio State University College of Medicine, receiving her MD degree in 1985. She was both a neurology resident and neuromuscular fellow at Johns Hopkins from 1986 -1992. She returned to Ohio State to join the faculty of the Neurology Department in 1992. Over the past 30 + years she has been involved in the care of patients with many neuromuscular disorders. However, the one area that she has devoted much of her time has been to the care and development of clinical treatments for patients with Myasthenia Gravis. In her role as the lead for the Myasthenia clinic, the Neuromuscular Division has participated in numerous clinical trials over the past 30 years including the seminal trials which have led to the approval of 3 medications for the treatment of MG. She continues to be involved in the development of new and innovative treatments for MG.
