

EOL Research Challenge

Big Idea:

Social media has been the source of medical information and misinformation. Creating a social media post, using data from research, shows how this tool can be used to spread accurate, evidence-based research. *(and it can make research fun)* Empower students to be factual presenters on and off line.

Objectives:

- Identify research related to EOL.
- Prioritize information to allow for powerful communication.
- Create a social media posting utilizing the research found.

Analyzing and applying research into nursing- presentation.

Look up **3 research articles** related to EOL care. Can be focused on any aspect or part of the EOL process.

Create a presentation in one of two formats- Blog write up or Tik Tok ‘style’ Challenge.

- Research articles must come from peer reviewed journals.
- At least one of the research articles must be within the last 5 years.
- Other resources allowed in addition to articles.
- Any aspect of EOL care is appropriate- medications, interventions, education, culture, age, anything else you might think of.

Blog Write Up	Tik Tok ‘style’ Challenge
Digital media is a great way to express thoughts or feelings regarding any topic or experience. A good blog is simple to read, has a couple bold ideas with a story or something to bring the reader in.	Digital media tool often used for spreading fun and silliness. However, the TikTok style can be used to educate and spread messages. It is simple in nature so ideas shared must be adapted to the quick style of presentation.
It is a more casual style of writing. While casual the writer still wants to understand their audience.	While TikTok is casual in nature the creator or presenter must be aware of the audience they want or will have watching it.
Images are important in a blog. It breaks up the writing to appeal to the visual part of the brain.	TikTok can have music in the background and has visual writing that can be read quickly.
Not all blogs have links to resources, many do, and it does give the blog more validity.	Tik Tok’s do not usually have resources, but they often have hashtags that lead to other links.

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What to do with this option: Blog	What to do with this option: Tik-Tok style Challenge
Write a blog 500-800 words pulling in the 3 research articles to tell a story, persuade or share something important to you.	Create a Tik-Tok style video- Doesn't need to use tiktok , feel free to use your iPad, iMovie, or any other recording and editing ability.
Need to have visual pieces throughout the blog. Ok to create this in a word or typed document. No public posting required.	30-60 seconds in length, pulling in data from the 3 research articles related to any topic in EOL care. No public posting required.
Needs to be a clear thought- "Think about what you are wanting to say?"	Needs to be a clear thought- "Think about what you are wanting to say?"
Appropriate for faculty, nurses, and patients to read.	Appropriate for faculty, nurses, and patients to view.
You can use more than 3 articles; all need to be on some sort of reference document and submitted with the blog	You can use more than 3 articles; all need to be on some sort of reference document and submitted with the video
Copies of the 3 articles need to be submitted with the blog	Copies of the 3 articles need to be submitted with the video
Creativity and reflection encouraged	Creativity and reflection encouraged
