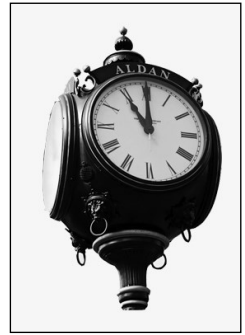

On Tuesday January 2nd 2024, the new session of the Aldan Borough Council was sworn in. The council members include reelected Democrats Harold "Buddy" Borders, Joyce Lambert, and Dan Procopio, who were sworn into office for a 2nd four year term, and newly elected Democrat Sue Kelley, who is Aldan Borough's Emergency Management Coordinator. Democrat Wadiya Ivery, Aldan's representative on the William Penn School Board, was sworn in for her 2nd four year term in December.

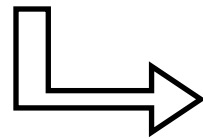

## MLK DAY SCHOOL SUPPLY DRIVE

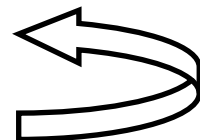

## THE PRIMARY IS COMING ON TUESDAY APRIL 23

2024 is a pivotal year for the United States of America and it is imperative that we reelect President Joe Biden and have a Democratic majority in both the US Senate and the US House of Representatives. Standing for reelection to represent us in Washington DC are President Joe Biden, Pennsylvania US Senator Robert Casey, Jr. and US Congress member Mary Gay Scanlon.

Just as important as our national representatives are those individuals who represent us in Harrisburg. This year on our ballot are Pennsylvania Attorney General, the state's top law officer; Pennsylvania Auditor General, the state's fiscal watchdog; Pennsylvania State Treasurer, the state's revenue person; and our member in the Pennsylvania House of Representatives.

To help Democratic Governor Josh Shapiro, we need to elect State Representative Heather Boyd to represent Aldan in Harrisburg. Additionally, Jack Stollsteimer, the current Delaware County DA is running for PA Attorney General, Malcolm Kenyatta, a State Representative from Philadelphia is running for PA Auditor General and Ryan Bizzarro, a State Representative from Erie, is running for PA State Treasurer.

All of the listed candidates are endorsed by the Aldan Democratic Organization and all except for Mary Gay Scanlon and Heather Boyd have primary opponents. Your vote on Election Day Tuesday, April 23, 2024 is critical to get our endorsed candidates on the November General Election ballot.

Your request for a mail-in ballot must be received by Tuesday, April 16, 2024. All mail-in ballots must be returned to the Delaware County Election Bureau or placed in the Ballot Drop Box located in the municipal parking lot at Providence Road and Clifton Avenue by 8 pm on Election Day, Tuesday, April 23, 2024.

## STATE REPRESENTATIVE HEATHER BOYD UPDATE

State Representative Heather Boyd has been busy working for us in Harrisburg and here in Delco. In Harrisburg, she obtained funding for local stormwater infrastructure, including \$213,563 for Aldan. She has been working on legislation to improve Pennsylvanians' access to healthcare and pushing for the state budget to include increased funding for our public schools.

Around the district, Rep. Boyd regularly holds Property Tax and Rent Rebate Program clinics to help eligible older and/or disabled adults get the relief they are entitled to. She has also recently held a FAFSA workshop and a shredding event, as well as co-hosting Aldan's Black History Month Celebration.
