

## Mystery Quilt Part Three

### Assembling 25 units of 4 blocks each:

Using the half square triangles made in Part two and the solid colour squares cut in Part One, assemble the following 6 different Units of 4. Sew the number shown for each 4 patch.

Fabric A is shown here in Blue and Fabric B is shown as Black Tweed, and Fabric C is White.

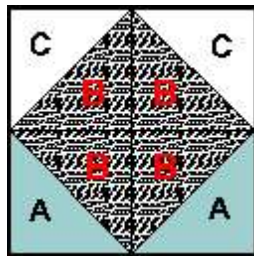
For the easiest assembly, first sew the 2 top pairs of squares for each unit, then the bottom pairs. Next, match the center seam (either nest or press open so that they lay nicely) and sew at the center to make your 4-patch.

If you used different fabrics for A, B, and/or C – assemble them randomly into these units.

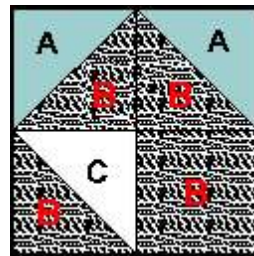
Unit 1 – make 4



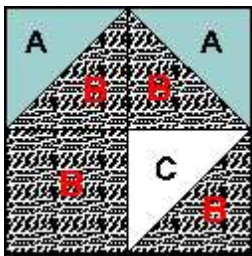
Unit 2 – make 8



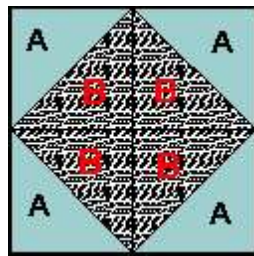
Unit 3 – make 4



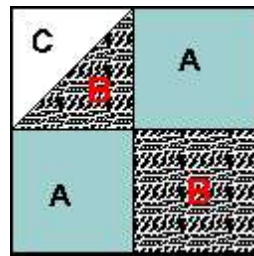
Unit 4 – make 4



Unit 5 – make 1

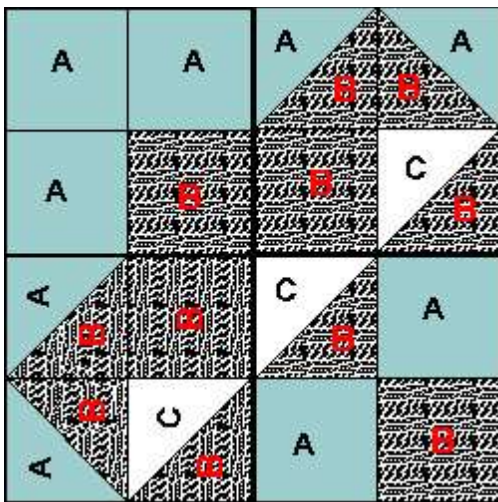


Unit 6 – make 4
