- Primary focus on heavy truck systems including A/C, air brake systems, high-pressure hydraulic systems, power train, drive line, refuse truck control and operation systems, all fire truck mechanical and electronic control systems, computerized power train systems, and electrical systems, as well as CNG fuel system repairs and maintenance;
- Weld, grind, and cut with a torch to perform repairs and fabrication of parts to facilitate repairs and improvements of vehicles.
