Test # 1 Class order: Intermediate, followed by Advanced, followed by Novice Test # 2 Class order: Advanced, followed by Intermediate, followed by Novice

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Condition of the Dog. Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the Fetch test. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs are allowed to enter so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the test, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

FNTRY FFFS

Entry fees: \$20 per test

No entries will be accepted prior to the day of the events. No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Check or cash only.

Entries accepted from 8:00am until 9:30am or until entry limits are reached, whichever is first.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

WAIT LIST INFORMATION

There will be no waitlist.

SIGN-IN & CRATING AREAS

There will be a secretary table for check-ins and information.

You will crate/work from your vehicle.

Dogs will be crated out of view of the Fetch test area, or far enough away as to not cause a distraction to the dog being tested.

BITCHES IN SEASON

Bitches in season may run at the end of the last trial run for the day. They will be required to wear panties and be confined away from the test area and waiting dogs until their time to run.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

These events will be held outdoors on artificial turf surface with no shade or water. You will need to provide shade and water for your dog(s).

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s) and providing their own clean up supplies. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors MUST check-in.

EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN: Check-in will begin at 8:00am and end at 9:30am. At check-in you will receive your run number.

It will save time if you print your entry form and fill it out prior to arriving at the test site. You must have a registration number from AKC to enter. (see Dogs Eligible to Enter above.)

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are able to perform safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the event committee, be asked to leave the event site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Rio Salgado Portuguese Water Dog Club of Arizona and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Rio Salgado Portuguese Water Dog Club of Arizona reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Rio Salgado Portuguese Water Dog Club of Arizona or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes, and Harnesses. Dogs must wear a collar. Dogs may wear slip collars, buckle collars, and Martingales in the AKC Fetch test. They may not wear prong collars, e-collars, head collars, muzzles, or body harnesses. Leashes should be 4 ft. to 6 ft. long and should be made of fabric, leather, or biothane.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the test area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.


Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.
