FROM THE MASONIC ANGEL FUND COMMITTEE

Brethren,

As many of you know, last year, myself and Worshipful Brothers Kris Bough and Jay Zayas got together to form a nonprofit organization to continue the functions of the Masonic Angel Fund in the memory of the late Ron Heald. For many reasons, particularly related to the length of the cable tow of many of us over the past, many months, managing and administrating this new organization has become difficult.

After much deliberation and consultation with the Worshipful Master and others, it was determined that the best course of action for us to take, in order to continue to have a charitable impact in our community and to meet the goals which we sent when incorporating the new Masonic Angel Fund, would be to dissolve the legal entity, which currently exist outside of Springfield Lodge, and return the remaining funds to the lodge. This dissolution would take place following all the rules and regulations set by state and federal law, and would be done with the understanding that the funds return to the lodge to be used for purposes, consistent with the goals of the Masonic Angel Fund.

Worshipful Kris and I have been afforded a few minutes to present this to the lodge at this months stated meeting, and can try to answer any questions at that time. If this is approved, myself and WBs Kris and Jay will meet to approve the dissolution, as well as a plan to dissolve the fund. We will close out our bank account and report the fund dissolved to the state government and the IRS to maintain compliance.

It is my hope that this step will make it much easier, with less roadblocks and hoops to jump through, for us to achieve some of the goals we had set for the Masonic Angel Fund, and for us to continue to live out our charitable mission as Masons, while honoring the legacy of our departed brother who so fervently exemplified that charity in his Masonic undertakings.
