Exhibit D

Insurance Requirements and Proof of Insurance

Proof of insurance coverage described below is attached to this Exhibit, with the Port Authority named as an additional insured.

Consultant shall maintain the following minimum insurance coverage:

- 1. Workers' Compensation:** Statutory coverage as required by the State of Michigan.
- 2. Liability:** Commercial general liability insurance coverage with minimum limits of \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate for bodily injury and property damage. ISO occurrence Form CG 0001 or equivalent is required.
- 3. Automotive:** Comprehensive automotive liability coverage with minimum limits of \$1,000,000 per accident for bodily injury and property damage. ISO Form CA 0001 or equivalent is required.
- 4. Professional Liability:** Professional liability insurance which includes coverage for the professional liability insurance which includes coverage for the professional acts, errors and omissions of Consultant in the amount of at least \$1,000,000.
- 5. Cyber Coverage:** Cyber Coverage with an aggregate limit of liability of \$1,000,000.
